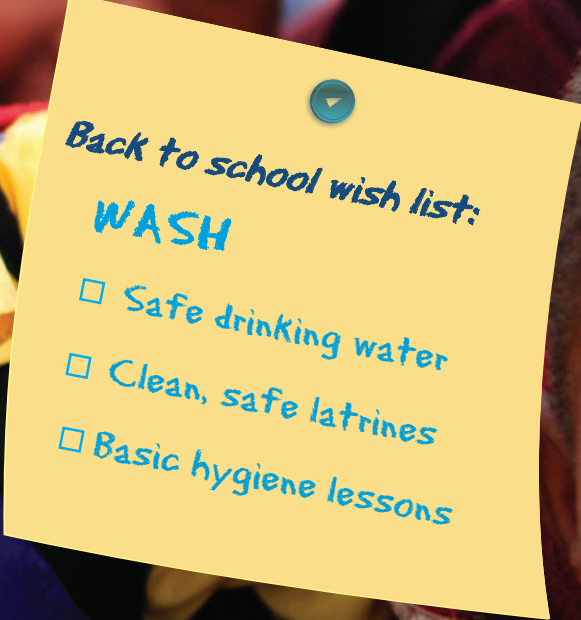


All kids need school. All schools need WASH. Help make it happen.

75 percent lack adequate sanitation (UNICEF). Children spend many of their hours collecting water. Children often have little choice but to drop out when schools are closed primarily by unsafe water and sanitation. Diarrhea causes children to miss school. Embarrassment, and aggravates malnutrition. Poor water and poor sanitation, millions of schoolchildren miss school. Poor school performance, increase drop-out rates. Cycle of poverty (UNICEF). Children who learn good hygiene and sanitation behaviors at school transmit their knowledge and practices to their families and to the broader community. WHO should participate in Back 2 School with WASH? Individuals, families, schools, Sunday school groups, civic groups, businesses, and churches—anyone who wants to help provide safe water, adequate sanitation, and hygiene education to schools in Africa.

WHAT does it involve? **Choose a goal.** Sponsor a child (\$20), family (\$100), classroom (\$1,600), or entire school (\$15,000). **Meet your goal** by donating today or by raising money through the activities suggested in this brochure.

- \$20** covers the cost of providing one student in East Africa with access to WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene education) at their primary school.
 - \$100** provides one family of five children in East Africa with access to WASH at their primary school.
 - \$1,600** funds access to WASH for one classroom of eighty children in Uganda, Kenya, or Ethiopia. (If desired, you may choose the country).
 - \$15,000** provides an entire school of five hundred to one thousand children in East Africa with access to WASH. (If desired, you may collaborate with us to select a school).
